Convictions Activity

Brandon Gabriel Mattingly – Mr. Mattingly was convicted of Criminal Mischief, 1st Degree and settled on a Diversion of 2 years, probated. The Fraudulent Insurance Acts charge was dismissed. Mr. Mattingly was ordered to pay \$1000 to the homeowner and \$1829.38 to DIFI for investigative costs.

<u>Matthew Barks</u> – Mr. Barks withdrew his former plea of not guilty on 6 felony counts and agreed to a guilty plea; the felony counts were amended to 6 misdemeanor convictions. The Defendant was sentenced to 12 months, that was probated for two years with conditions. He was fined \$2200.00 to be paid to the Kentucky Department of Insurance, for investigative expenses.
