Convictions Activity

<u>Stephen Shawn Rowe</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea on four felony counts with Magoffin Circuit Court. Mr. Rowe's sentence has been amended to probation for a period of 5 years and he has been ordered to pay restitution totaling \$36,724.45; \$32,764.45 to Salyersville Waterworks and \$3,960.00 to Aflac. Amounts to be paid by the sentencing date.

<u>Catherine Edmonds</u> – Information provided lead to one felony conviction with the United States District Court, Western District of Kentucky, Louisville Division. Ms. Edmonds was sentenced to probation for a term of 2 years and was not ordered to pay restitution.

<u>Ijaz Mahmood</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea on two felony counts with the United States District Court, Western District of Kentucky, Louisville Division. Dr. Mahmood was sentenced to two years of supervised release and ordered to pay restitution in the amount of \$117,209.00 paid to the United States District Court.
