<u>Christopher G. Hickerson</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea agreement on 2 Felony Counts with the United States District Court, District of Kentucky-Central Division at Lexington. Mr. Hickerson has been sentenced to 66 months imprisonment with the Federal Bureau of Prisons. A restitution amount for Mr. Hickerson has not been determined at this time and an amount will be posted at a later date.

<u>Ronnie Jolly</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea agreement on 4 Felony Counts with the United States District Court, District of Kentucky-Central Division at Lexington. Mr. Jolly has been sentenced to 3 years imprisonment with the Federal Bureau of Prisons. A Restitution amount for Mr. Jolly has not been determined at this time and an amount will be posted at a later date.

<u>David Leech</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea agreement on one Felony Count with the United States District Court, District of Kentucky-Central Division at Lexington. Mr. Leech has been sentenced to 5 years Federal probation. According to the Federal restitution ordered, Mr. Jolly has been ordered to pay \$940,754 (joint and several with Earl Plank). Earl Plank has not been sentenced at this time.

<u>Brandon Price</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea agreement on one Felony Count with the United States District Court, District of Kentucky-Central Division at Lexington. Mr. Price has been sentenced to 6 months imprisonment with the Federal Bureau of Prisons and ordered to pay \$110,257 in restitution.

<u>Jimmy Price</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea agreement on one Felony Count with the United States District Court, District of Kentucky-Central Division at Lexington. Mr. Price has been sentenced to 6 months imprisonment with the Federal Bureau of Prisons and ordered to pay \$110,257 in restitution.

<u>Brad Price</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea agreement on one Felony Count with the United States District Court, District of Kentucky-Central Division at Lexington. Mr. Price has been sentenced to 30 months imprisonment with the Federal Bureau of Prisons. According to the Federal restitution ordered, Mr. Price has been ordered to pay \$460,624. Part of Brad Price's restitution is joint and several with Mike McNew and Tim Snedegar which will be deducted from their restitution when they go to court.

<u>Robert Livingood</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea agreement on one Felony Count with the United States District Court, District of Kentucky-Central Division at Lexington. Mr. Livingood has been sentenced to 366 days imprisonment with the Federal Bureau of Prisons. According to the Federal restitution ordered, Mr. Livingood has been ordered to pay \$313,652 (joint and several with Roger Wilson). Roger Wilson has not been sentenced at this time.

<u>Jesse Smith</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea agreement on one Felony Count with the United States District Court, District of Kentucky-Central Division at Lexington. Mr. Smith has been sentenced to one day (time served) imprisonment with the Federal Bureau of Prisons. According to the Federal restitution ordered, Mr. Smith has been ordered to pay \$116,845 (joint and several with Earl Planck). Earl Planck has not been sentenced at this time.
