He was ordered to pay \$5,832.00 to Frankfort Housing Authority and \$2,035.00 to the KY Department of Insurance for investigative expenses.

<u>Goodnight, Darren J.</u> – Mr. Goodnight was ordered to pay \$1,333.33 in restitution for Fraudulent Insurance Acts over \$500, 1 count. He was also ordered to pay \$403.76 to the KY Department of Insurance, Division of Insurance Fraud Investigations, for investigative expenses.
