Convictions Activity

<u>Demond Wells, JR</u> – Mr. Wells changed his plea from Not Guilty to Guilty to a Class D Felony, in Kenton Circuit Court, 10/26/2022. Mr. Wells was ordered to pay a restitution amount of \$6,800 to KY Farm Bureau in April of 2023.

<u>Jason Lee Dobbs</u> – Mr. Dobbs was found guilty as charged on 3 counts of Fraudulent Insurance Acts over \$500, a Class D Felony, in Daviess County Circuit Court. He was sentenced up to 5 years in the penitentiary and ordered to pay \$5,492.27 in restitution and \$2,311.51 in investigative expenses.

<u>Jack Strunk</u> – Mr. Strunk plead guilty on one felony count, Fraudulent Insurance Acts-\$500 or > but < than \$10,000 - 304.47-020(2), in Garrard County Circuit Court. The court agreed to a pretrial diversion for 3 years and a restitution amount to the Kentucky Department of Insurance, Division of Fraud Investigations of \$3,261.30.

<u>Ashley (Sparks) Honaker</u> – Ms. Honaker paid \$7,320 in restitution to AFLAC to avoid charges and a conviction.

<u>Dustin M. Siletchnik</u> – Plead guilty to two felony charges. Mr. Siletchnik agreed to a pretrial diversion of 5 years on each count and agreed to pay Americo Financial Life \$1,627.12, restitution.
