Criminal Convictions

<u>David M. Flynn</u> – Mr. Flynn plead guilty to one count of Fraudulent Insurance Acts over \$500.00, and was sentenced to a 5-year pretrial diversion, and 30 days of home incarceration. He was also ordered to pay AFLAC a total of \$3,325.00 in restitution through the Henderson County Circuit Clerk's Office.

<u>Melissa Romine</u> – Ms. Romine plead guilty to an amended charge of Theft by Deception Over \$500.00, but less than \$10,000.00. She was sentenced to three years, diverted for a period of five years. Additionally, she has been ordered to pay restitution in the amount of \$34,942.00 to the Kentucky Workers Compensation Special Fund. Payments were ordered to begin on December 15th, 2018, in the amount of \$190.00 monthly.
