Convictions Activity

<u>Vazquez, Carolos</u> – An investigation led to a Federal Indictment and a guilty plea to one felony count, Conspiracy to Commit Health Care Fraud. Mr. Vazquez was sentenced to supervised probation for a term of 5 years, with mandatory conditions. He was ordered to pay \$343,832.41 in restitution.

<u>Peguero, Junis</u> – An investigation led to a Federal Indictment and a guilty plea to two felony counts, Conspiracy to Commit Health Care Fraud and Mail Fraud. Mr. Peguero has been sentenced to a term of 31 months and committed to the custody of the Federal Bureau of Prisons. Upon release he will be on supervised probation for a period of three years, with mandatory conditions. Mr. Peguero has been ordered to pay \$343,832.41 in restitution.

<u>Cardenas, Miguel Moreno</u> - An investigation led to a Federal Indictment and a guilty plea to two felony counts, Conspiracy to Commit Health Care Fraud and Mail Fraud. Mr. Cardenas has been sentenced to a term of 14 months and committed to the custody of the Federal Bureau of Prisons, Upon release he will be on supervised probation for a period of two years, with mandatory conditions. Mr. Cardenas has been ordered to pay \$343,832.41 in restitution.

<u>Cordoba-Reira, Jose</u> - An investigation led to a Federal Indictment and a guilty plea to two felony counts, Conspiracy to Commit Health Care Fraud and Conspiracy to Commit Money Laundering. Mr. Cordoba-Reira has been sentenced to a term of 14 months and committed to the custody of the Federal Bureau of Prisons, Upon release he will be on supervised probation for a period of two years, with mandatory conditions. Mr. Cordoba-Reira has been ordered to pay \$343,832.41 in restitution.

<u>Calloway, Collin</u> - An investigation led to a guilty plea of one count Fraudulent Insurance Acts over \$500, Class D Felony, Harlan Circuit Court. Mr. Calloway's 5 years imprisonment sentence was probated to supervised probation for 5 years, plus restitution of \$2,031.92 to The Traveler's Indemnity Co.

<u>Taulbee</u>, <u>Randall D.</u> - An investigation led to a Federal Indictment and a guilty plea to two felony counts, both Conspiracy to Commit an Offense Against the United States. Mr. Taulbee has been sentenced to thirty months imprisonment and ordered to pay a total of \$718, 784 in restitution; \$458,104 is to be paid to Risk Management Agency and \$260,680 to AgriSompo North America.

<u>Noble, Cherie Lynn</u> - An investigation led to a Federal Indictment and a guilty plea to one felony count, Conspiracy to Commit an Offense Against the United States. Ms. Noble has been sentenced to two years' probation and ordered to pay \$263,614 in restitution; \$166,602 is to be paid to Risk Management Agency and \$97,012 to AgriSompo North America.

McDonald, James A. - An investigation led to a Federal Indictment and a guilty plea to two felony counts, both Conspiracy to Commit an Offense Against the United States. Mr. McDonald has been sentenced to 6 months imprisonment and ordered to pay a total of \$718,784 in restitution; \$458,104 to be paid to Risk Management Agency and \$260,680 to AgriSompo North America (Formerly ARMtech Insurance Solutions).

<u>Chaney, Melonie</u> - An investigation led to a guilty plea and settlement of Fraudulent Insurance Acts, Over \$500. The Ms. Chaney took a plea and agreed to DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE upon payment in full of Investigative Expenses awarded to the Kentucky Department of Insurance, Division of Fraud Investigations, \$1500, paid in full on 10/23/2023.
