Convictions Activity

<u>Jones, Diane Marie</u> – A case was opened as an assist to the Lexington Fire Department. The information provided lead to a guilty plea on two felony counts (1 count Arson, 2nd Degree and 1 count Burning Personal Property to Defraud Insurer) against Diane Marie Jones and two codefendants, Mark Jones, and Harry Holiman, for a total of six felony convictions. Each defendant has been sentenced to 10 years probated to two years' probation. Restitution was ordered on each defendant in the amount of \$209.94 for a total to be paid of \$629.82 to GEICO.

<u>Christopher Nelson</u> – Mr. Nelson pleaded guilty on 4 felony counts in the United States District Court, Western District of Kentucky, Louisville Division. He has been sentenced to two years' probation and shall pay restitution to the following: Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Svc. Medicare, \$604,503.90 and to Kentucky Medicaid Program, \$121,068.20 for a total of \$725,572.10.

<u>Stephen D. Keen</u> – Mr. Keen took an "Alford" plea to Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument and Fraudulent Insurance acts with Henderson Circuit Court. The Court granted a Pretrial Diversion for a period of two years and restitution to be paid to Henderson Circuit Court Clerk's Office in the amount of \$15,303.15.
