Convictions Activity

<u>Vivian R. Ford</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea agreement on 1 count Fraudulent Insurance Acts over \$500 and an agreement to a restitution order totaling \$2,700, with Hardin County Circuit Clerk, Kentucky; \$2,700 was awarded to AFLAC Insurance Company. Ms. Ford was sentenced to 5 years' probation.

<u>Michael Muller</u> – Information provided lead to a guilty plea agreement on 1 count Fraudulent Insurance Acts over \$500 and an agreement to a restitution order totaling \$6,464.20, with Madison County Circuit Clerk, Kentucky; \$2,601.60 was awarded to Westfield Insurance Company and \$3,862.60 was awarded to KY DOI Fraud Division for investigative expenses. Mr. Muller was sentenced to two years prison.

<u>Charlie Jones</u> – Information provided let to a guilty plea agreement on 1 count Fraudulent Insurance Acts over \$500 and 1 count of Wanton Endangerment, Second Degree. Mr. Jones also agreed to \$7,295 restitution to be paid to Kentucky Farm Bureau. He was sentenced to 3 years 9 months imprisonment.

<u>James Gregory</u> – Information provided let to a guilty plea agreement on 1 count Fraudulent Insurance Acts over \$500 and 1 count of Wanton Endangerment, Second Degree. Mr. Gregory also agreed to \$7,295 restitution to be paid to Kentucky Farm Bureau. He was sentenced to 3 years 6 months imprisonment.
