## **Convictions Activity**

<u>Abad, Joel</u> – Mr. Abad was found guilty on three felony counts in the United States District Court, Western District of Kentucky, Louisville Division. He was given a 3-year probation sentence. He was ordered to pay restitution along with 4 other subjects (joint and several) in this case. The restitution amount was reported in 2023.

<u>Cole, Jerry</u> – Mr. Cole changed his plea of not guilty too guilty. He received two misdemeanor convictions and one felony conviction. He was sentenced to probation, with conditions, for 5 years.

<u>Don Hall Supercenter</u> – An investigation into Vendor Fraud by Don Hall Supercenter/Auto Body led to a restitution agreement to avoid prosecution. Don Hall Supercenter agreed to pay restitution in the amount of \$132,158.36. Due to the restitution agreement and amount paid in full, and the fact that Don Hall Supercenter was sold and completed on 2/1/2024, prosecution was declined by Commonwealth's Attorney Rhonda M. Copley.
