In addition we suggest review of Advisory Opinion 2004-03.

Should an insurer wish to create its own Certificate of Insurance form to be used by the company and its appointed agents, it may do so. However such form must be filed and receive approval prior to use in Kentucky pursuant to $\frac{KRS\ 304.14-120}{KRS\ 304.14-120}$. The form must comply with $\frac{806\ KAR\ 14:006}{KRS\ 304.14-120}$.
